### AGGREGATOR

The **AGGREGATOR Database** is the **Atlas of Global Governance REGulation and Europe's AcTORness**. This dataset will be the result of the merging of two separate datasets, one on global governance and international regulatory cooperation developed in WP1, and the other on EU governance developed in WP2. The combined dataset will be integrated in a single software, which will incorporate a **guided tool for the evaluation of EU actorness and influence**.



### COCTEAU

The app **COCTEAU - Co-Creating the European Union** aims to be an experimental tool for public engagement. The development of COCTEAU will have as main partners a core team of POLIMI (leader), FRA, CEPS and ISINNOVA and, will be tested within the Mission Oriented Innovation Policies of the EU.



### PERSEUS

An integrated toolkit for participatory and strategic decision-making at the EU level, called **PERSEUS - Public Engagement for Responsive and Shared European Union Strategies**, will be created. It incorporates the various tools developed in WP5 and WP6, and will be tested during the deep dives in WP7. This tool will incorporate the AGGREGATOR database, the COCTEAU app, a module on AI-powered sentiment analysis, and the information and tools developed in all other WPs of the project.

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## THE PROJECT

The ultimate objectives of TRIGGER are to provide EU institutions with knowledge and tools to enhance their actorness, effectiveness and influence in global governance; and to develop new ways to harness the potential of public engagement and participatory foresight in complex governance decisions, thereby also tackling emerging trends such as nationalism, regionalism and protectionism.

### TRIGGER specific objectives are:

- ✕ Advance the state of the art in understanding global governance;
- ✕ Evolution of the EU's interaction with global governance, in particular the so-called "actorness" and "effectiveness" of the EU;
- ✕ Understand how global governance and emerging technologies interact, and what roles the EU plays in this respect, in particular as a "regulatory superpower";
- ✕ Identify emerging trends that strengthen / loosen deeper global governance and cooperation;
- ✕ Build capacity for strategic foresight and public engagement inside EU institutions.

The project is divided in 8 technical Work Packages and 2 management Work Packages, undergoing throughout the 3 years of the project implementation (From December 2018 to November 2021).
